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01 Who we are

ADAPT Security & Medical provides integrated medical and security cover for live events, bringing clinical care and licensed security operations under one command structure — so clients get a single point of accountability for safety, not two suppliers to coordinate.

 - Insured medical and security services
 - Structured ePCR and incident reporting
 - Risk assessments and deployment plans
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Most events source medical, security and safeguarding cover from separate suppliers, each running its own reporting line and its own version of what happened. ADAPT deploys all three under one operational command: a single incident log, one radio network, and one Designated Safeguarding Lead who can see the whole picture as it develops — not just their part of it.

That matters most in the moment it's tested: a medical incident that has a safeguarding dimension, or a security response that needs clinical judgement alongside it. Our teams train and deploy together, so the handover between disciplines happens on-site, in real time, rather than after the event in a debrief.

Medical

Risk-led event and venue medical provision, scaled from welfare cover through to major-incident readiness.

Security

Licensed security personnel focused on safe operations, confident communication and the reputation of the venue.

Welfare & safeguarding

A Designated Safeguarding Lead on every deployment — and that title means something specific. Our safeguarding leads hold Level 4 safeguarding qualifications: the level expected of someone with strategic, organisation-wide safeguarding responsibility, not the awareness-level training most frontline staff carry. In practice that means the person making the call on-site is trained to manage complex disclosures and multi-agency liaison directly, rather than simply recognising a concern and escalating it up a chain. The rest of the team is trained and vetted to support that lead, not to replace the judgement they bring.

- Enhanced DBS-checked, Level 2+ safeguarding-trained staff
- Escalation into medical, security and external services
- Direct liaison with LADOs and local safeguarding partnerships

Training

SECURITY	All security personnel hold current SIA licences, checked and refreshed in line with SIA requirements.
CLINICAL	HCPC-registered clinical leadership across our medical teams, practising within scope.
INSURANCE	Insured medical and security services, with cover confirmed for each deployment.
VETTING	All staff hold enhanced DBS checks and remain on the UK DBS Update Service.
CT AWARENESS	All staff hold a valid ACT (Action Counters Terrorism) Awareness certificate, renewed within the last 12 months.
DATA	Data handling complies with UK GDPR and the Data Protection Act 2018, including special category health data.
TERRORISM	Preparing for duties under the Terrorism (Protection of Premises) Act 2025 ("Martyn's Law"), ahead of commencement expected Spring 2027 and SIA enforcement oversight.
SAFEGUARDING	Safeguarding led at Level 4, with policy and procedures reviewed on a scheduled cycle and escalation routes to LADO contacts.
PLANNING STANDARDS	Deployment plans reference The Purple Guide (events) and the Green Guide, Guide to Safety at Sports Grounds (sport), as relevant to the booking.
